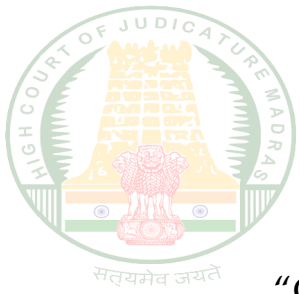
Prayer :-
