PETITION FOR BAIL UNDER SEC 483 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.343 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 10.09.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 303(2) of BNS, 2023 r/w. Section 21(1) and 21(4) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulations) Act, 1957 in Crime No.343 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.



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2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein and other accused had illegally transported 1 unit of M-sand. Hence, the case.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent Police.

4. Considering the nature of allegation and also considering the undertaking of the petitioner to show his bonafide he is ready and willing to deposit a sum of Rs.2,000/- and also considering the fact that the petitioner is in jail from 10.09.2024, I am inclined enlarge the petitioner on bail on certain conditions.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankovil, Tenkasi District.

[i] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Special Court/concerned Court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[ii] As per undertaken, the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) to the credit of Headmaster, Government Higher Secondary School, G.Udayapatti, Kulithalai, Karur District, (Account No.31470991902, CIF No; 85896796279, IFSC Code: SBIN0000863, State Bank of India,



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Kulithalai Branch), without prejudice to their rights and contentions before the trial
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Court;

(iii)The petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m,
for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[iv] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

[v] the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.

[vi] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial
Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in
accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner
released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the
Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[vii] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under
Section 229A IPC.
