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ORDER

4. At this juncture, the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner would submit that the writ petitioner is ready to give a fresh representation before the second respondent.



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5. Recording the submissions made on either side, the writ petitioner is directed to give a fresh representation to the second respondent and on receipt of the same, the second respondent is directed to issue notice to the writ petitioner as well as to the private respondent and conduct enquiry and pass orders within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the representation.

6. With the above directions, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
