Considering the difficulty expressed by the learned counsel for the petitioners that there is a life threat to the petitioners and it is also represented that the investigation is completed and a charge sheet is filed, the said condition is modified to the effect that 'the petitioner shall report before the Flower Bazaar Police station, Chennai, for a period of four weeks and also attend for all the hearings without fail'. All other conditions in the order dated 26.09.2024, shall remain unaltered.

4.In view of the above, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed.
