ORDER

In view thereof, the petitioner's representation dated 30.08.2024, shall be considered in the next Committee Meeting or at the earliest and appropriate orders shall be passed in accordance with law in any event, not later than the three months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

5. Recording the same, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed. No costs.
