2. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the State would submit that on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner, enquiry is pending in current paper. He would further submit that the



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petitioner as well as the fourth respondent are claiming right to construct the temple.

Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), the third respondent is directed to issue notice to the petitioner as well as the private respondent and conduct enquiry and take a decision within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
