The prayer sought for in these Writ Petitions has now been achieved in view of the fact that subsequent to the filing of these Writ Petitions, the amount spent by the petitioner towards his

No prejudice will be caused if such a liberty is granted.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to submit a representation to the respondents seeking for payment of interest if he so desires and the respondents shall consider the same on merits and in accordance with law. There shall be no order as to costs.
