PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.254 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 281, 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and r/w. Section 25(1)(a) of Arms Act, 1959 and u/s. 128 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 in Crime.No.254 of 2024, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein has threatened

the defacto complainant by showing the deadly weapons. Hence, the complaint.

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3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent Police and perused the materials available on record.

4. Considering the nature of allegation in this case that the petitioner herein wielding the weapons threatened the public when the police party arrived at the scene of occurrence and considering the age of the accused and that he is a daily labour working in the construction work, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. But however certain conditions to stay away and to continue his work and he is being the breadwinner of his family.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Veda sandhur, Dindigul District on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;



(b) The petitioner shall stay at Coimbatore and report before the Singanallur police station daily at 6.30 pm for a period of two months and keep inform about the said Investigating Officer and also the investigating officer of the present case as to the place of his work every day and the Investigating Officer shall monitor whether the petitioner goes for work every day;

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]*; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
