ORDER

The instant writ petition has been filed by a Nayak working in TSP XIV Battalion, Palani, seeking a mandamus to direct the respondents to furnish the documents that are annexure to the charge memo, issued to the writ petitioner on 10.07.2024 based upon his representation made on various dates.

2.A perusal of the charge memo indicates that as per annexure 3 to the said charge memo, 26 documents are relied upon by the department for the charges levied as against the writ petitioner. According to the petitioner, these documents have not furnished to him and he has prayed for furnishing of these documents before participating in the departmental enquiry.

3.Considering the above said facts, the third respondent is directed to furnish a copy of all the 26 documents referred to in annexure 3 of the charge memo, dated 10.07.2024 within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



4. With the above said observations, this writ petition stands disposed of.
