PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to revise the petitioner scale of pay based on the 14th wage settlement, dated

ORDER

The present Writ Petition has been filed by a retired Special Server Cleaner L-5 of the respondent Transport Corporation seeking benefits under the 14th wage settlement, dated 24.08.2022.

2. According to the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, though the petitioner has retired from service on 31.05.2022, the 14th wage settlement is applicable to all those employees who were in service on 01.09.2019. The petitioner has sent a representation to the respondents on 12.09.2024 seeking the said benefits. Since there is no response, the present writ petition has been filed.
