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PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the difference amounts in the benefits in respect of Gratuity, Encashment of Earned Leave Salary, Commuted value of pension and monthly pension with arrears from the date of retirement to the petitioner as per the Wage Revision Settlement dated 24.08.2022 together with interest at 6% per annum for the differential payment to be computed from the date of his retirement i.e., 31.01.2020 till the date of payment within a time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

The present Writ Petition has been filed by a Special Grade Driver of the respondent Transport Corporation seeking to pay the difference amounts in the benefits of Gratuity, Encashment of Earned Leave Salary, Commuted value of pension and monthly pension along with arrears from the date of



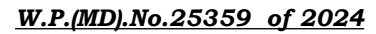
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retirement, as per the 14th Wage Settlement, dated 24.08.2022 along with interest.

2. Seeking the said benefits, the petitioner has sent a representation to the respondents on 15.07.2024. Since there is no response, the present Writ Petition has been filed.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent and the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents 2 to 4.

4. Considering the above said facts, the respondents 2 to 4 herein are directed to confer the eligible benefits upon the writ petitioner along with interest at the rate of 6% p.a., from the due date, till the date of disbursement, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
