PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents (i) to settle all the retirement benefits of the petitioner, like the Pension, DCRG, Commutation of Pension etc, after granting the due increments and refixing her pay, within a time limit fixed by this Hon'ble Court, with interest at the rate of 18% p.a., from the date of her retirement on 30.04.2015 till the date of payment (ii) to pay the increment and salary arrears (iii) to pay the



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damage/compensation for the demise of the petitioner's husband, due to the non-payment of retirement benefits including pension and (iv) to direct the first respondent to take appropriate departmental disciplinary action as against the respondents 2 to 7/the erring officials for the inordinate delay in settling the retirement benefits.

ORDER

The instant writ petition has been filed by a retired Tutor/Assistant Professor seeking a Mandamus for disbursement of her terminal benefits along with interest.

2. A perusal of the records indicate that the petitioner had attained superannuation on 30.04.2015 and so far the terminal benefits have not been released. It could be seen from the affidavit that her leave period between 02.04.2006 and 18.07.2006, while she was working in Kanyakumari Government Medical College Hospital, have not been regularized.



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5. With the above said observations, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently connected Miscellaneous Petition stands closed.
