PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL UNDER SECTION 482 OF BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.117 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent



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ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioners/ Accused, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 153(A), 295, 295(A), 296, 341 of IPC, in Crime No.117 of 2022, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity with regard to trusteeship of the temple, the petitioners put the lock in the temple premises. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

4.The learned Counsel appearing for the intervenor would submit that the defacto complaint is only the trustee of the temple and without any proprietary, these accused persons wrongfully locked the temple itself.

5.Considering nature of allegations in this case that the petitioners are said to have put the lock in the temple on account of dispute with reference to the trusteeship of the temple and considering the fact that the occurrences is of the year 2022, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, this Petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, within a period of fifteen



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days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Srivilliputhur, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. It is made clear that no relaxation of the condition for the said period will be entertained by this court;

(c) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by



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the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

(f)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
