2. Mr.E.Antony Sahaya Prabahar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition

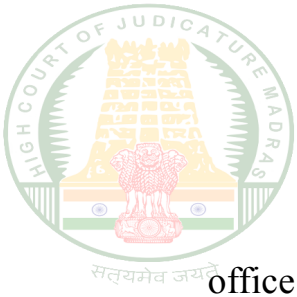

The learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioners would submit that though the writ petitioners representing the Trichy District Waste Paper Association have given complaints to the first respondent, there was no further action on the part of the first respondent and that the first respondent has not even forwarded the complaint to the third respondent.

4. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that the first respondent may be directed to forward the writ petitioners' complaint to the third respondent.

5. Recording the submissions made on either side, the first respondent is directed to forward the writ petitioners' complaint dated 19.10.2024 to the third respondent and on receipt of the same, the third respondent is directed to consider the same and take a decision within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the complaint from the
