PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.739/2024 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, who is arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 10.10.2024 for the offence punishable under Sections 296(b), 132, 351(3) of BNS, 2023



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r/w. Section 25(1-A) of Arms Act, 1959 in Crime No.739 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 10.10.2024, the petitioner is said to have wielded weapons and created nuisance in the public place. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

4.Considering the nature of occurrence in this case that the petitioner is said to have wielded weapon and threatened the public, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvudaimaruthur;

(i)the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(ii)the petitioner shall stay at Dindigul and report before the Inspector of Police, Dindigul Town Police Station, Dindigul, daily at 10.30 a.m., up to 03.11.2024 and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. It is made clear that no



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relaxation of the condition for the said period will be entertained by this court;

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(iii)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

(iv)the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.

(v)On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

(vi) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
