ORDER

The Criminal Original Petition has been filed, invoking Section 528 B.N.S.S., seeking orders to direct the first respondent to transfer the investigation pertaining to Crime No.64 of 2022 from second respondent police to some other police officer within the jurisdiction of the first respondent and to file final report within the stipulated time.

2. It is seen from the records that on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner, FIR came to be registered in Crime No.64 of 2022 on 23.07.2022 for the offences under Sections 66 of Information Technology (Amendment) Act 2008 INF C and Section 420 IPC.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents would submit that they have freezed two bank accounts and investigation is pending and seeks three months time to file a final report before the concerned Court.



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4. Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), the second respondent is directed to complete the investigation in Crime No.64 of 2022 and file a final report before the jurisdictional Court within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
