PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.71/2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/ Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 20.02.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 397 and 506(ii) IPC in crime No.71 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein waylaid the defacto



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complainant and robbed a sum of Rs.1,200/- from him. Hence, the case.

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3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent and perused the materials available on record.

4. Considering the nature of allegation in this case that the petitioner along with the other accused violated the defacto complainant and snatched a sum of Rs.1,200/- and considering the fact that the petitioner did not comply with the condition for bail and therefore, he was again committed to prison and considering the fact that the petitioner is in jail from 20.02.2024 and now the investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Dindigul.

(i)the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(ii)the petitioner shall attend all the hearing dates before the trial Court without fail;



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(iii) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

(iv) the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.

(v) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

(vi) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
