PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.524 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A1, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on
14.09.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b) and 351(2) of BNS and

Section 4 of TNPWH Act @ 296(b), 351(2) & 108 of BNS and Section 4 of TNPWH Act,

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in Crime No.524 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

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2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant and her husband borrowed money from the petitioner for business purpose. Thereafter, they failed to repay the same. Due to which, the petitioner and the other accused are said to have harassed the defacto complainant and his husband for non-payment of the amount. Thereby, they consumed poison. Even though the defacto complainant recovered, her husband died at the hospital without responding to the treatment. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard both sides.

4.Considering the nature of the allegations in this case that the petitioner, who is an employee of the private concern, also gave money to the deceased for exorbitant interest and the deceased did not repay the same, and the petitioner and the other accused are said to have shamed him in public by catching his collar, on account of which he had committed suicide, and considering the fact that the petitioner is in prison from 14.09.2024, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner on certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the



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Judicial Magistrate Court, Melur.

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(i)the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(ii)the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation;

(iii)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

iv)the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.

v)On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

vi)If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
