A.DEVAKI, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.M.SAKTHI KUMAR, Government Advocate (Crl.side) on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

This petition has been filed to suspend the sentence imposed by the learned Sessions Judge-Mahalir Fast Track Court, Dindigul, dated 29.09.2022 in Spl.S.C.No.90 of 2020.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that this is the third suspension of sentence petition. Earlier petitions filed by the petitioner in Crl.MP (MD)No.13186 of 2022 and Crl.MP(MD)No.8333 of 2023 were dismissed by this Court, dated 07.11.2022 and 20.06.2023 respectively.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would submit that there is no change of circumstance.

4.This is the third application and in this petition, there is no grounds differ from the earlier petitions' grounds. Hence, this Court does not find any merit to entertain this petition.



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5.Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.
