PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 218 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused No.1, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 296(b), 109(2) and 351(3) of

BNS, 2023 in Crime No.218 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and another accused person assaulted the defacto complainant and her husband and caused serious injuries. There are totally two accused persons in this case and this petitioner is arrayed as Accused No.1.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent Police submitted that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and that there are four previous cases against the petitioner.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and also the change in circumstances that has taken place after the dismissal of the previous Anticipatory Bail Petition filed in CrI.O.P.(MD).No.17405 of 2024, dated 09.10.2024, whereby, the injured has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Karaikudi, Sivagangai District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only), with two sureties, each for a

like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the said Magistrate, on further condition that:

[a] if the petitioner fails to surrender before the said Magistrate within a period of fifteen days, this order shall stand automatically cancelled.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on every Friday at 05.30 p.m. for a period of six weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

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[f] if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
