Prayer in CRL RC(MD). 1150/ 2024 :

To call for the entire records pertaining to the judgment delivered by the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Vendasandur, Dindigul District in C.C No. 54/2021 vide judgment dt. 18.04.2022 by convicting the petitioner under sec 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and sentenced him to undergo 6 months S.I. and to pay a compensation of Rs.5,00,000/- to the Respondent within one month with 6% interest per annum in default 3 months S.I which was subsequently confirmed by the

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Additional District & Sessions Court, Dindigul in C.A.No.20/2022 vide judgement dated 29/10/2024 and set aside the same and consequently acquit the petitioner honorably.
