Prayer in CrI.OP(MD)No.16318 of 2024:- Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, to direct the learned Special Judge for Trial of Cases under SC/ST (POA)Act, Sivagangai District to dispose of the bail application to be filed by the petitioner on merits on the same day of their surrender before the above mentioned Court in pending investigation of Crime No.114 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

2.The learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner could not surrender before the concerned Court within the stipulated time as prescribed by this Court.



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3.Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is allowed and time is extended by two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. It is made clear that no further extension will be granted.”
