Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying this Court to issue a Writ of Declaration, declaring that the entire roll of members of IMCOPS without removing the names of the doctors of Indian Medicine who are in the service of the Department of the Health and Family Welfare of the Tamil Nadu Government / any other department of the State Government directly and through the National Rural Health Mission scheme, from the membership of IMCOPS as arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional, null and void and consequently direct the respondents 3 and 4 to disqualify and declare the cessation of membership of all the doctors of Indian Medicine who are in the service of the Department of the Health and Family Welfare of the Tamil Nadu Government/any other department of the State Government directly and through the National Rural Health Mission scheme in the roll of members of (IMPCOPS) the Indian Medical Practitioner's Co-operative Pharmacy and Stores, Thiruvanmiyur, Chennai.
