PRAYER in W.P.(MD)No.21273 of 2017: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the impugned order of rejection passed by the respondent university published in their official website, rejecting the petitioner's case for admission to 3 LLB Degree Course for affiliated Government Law Colleges in Tamil Nadu for the Academic Year 2017-2018 and quash the same as illegal and consequently directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for
