On perusal of the representations submitted by the petitioner, it is seen that the petitioner made representations seeking for a direction to restrain the private respondents herein from interfering with the construction activity in respect of the subject temple. The subject temple is a private temple and the dispute is between the petitioner and the private respondents herein. Therefore, the official respondents herein have no role to act on the representations submitted by the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, the representations submitted by the petitioner cannot be considered and this writ petition is devoid of merits and the same is dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file a civil suit for getting appropriate relief. No costs.
