PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL UNDER SECTION 482 OF BNSS



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PRAYER :-

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For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 127 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/accused No.1 to 4, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under 296(b), 176(2), 324(4), 324(5), 115 (2), 118(1), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 4 of TNPWH Act in Crime No.127 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 17.11.2024, a cattle belonging to A1 entered into the agricultural land of the defacto complainant. This was questioned and therefore, there was a wordy quarrel. The other accused persons also came to the scene of occurrence and they started shouting at the defacto complainant and his wife in filthy language and the two wheeler was also damaged. They also prevented the defacto complainant from giving a police complaint.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent Police.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of this case and considering the nature of the dispute between the parties, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners subject to the following conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail in



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the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvadanai, Ramanathapuram District, on condition that the petitioners shall execute bonds for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two common sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the said Magistrate, on further condition that:

[a] if the petitioners fail to surrender before the said Magistrate within a period of fifteen days, this order shall stand automatically cancelled.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;



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[f] if the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
