### **ORDER**

The present Writ Petition has been filed by a retired Senior Grade Driver of the respondent Transport Corporation, who had attained superannuation on 30.09.2018 seeking the payment of interest for the belated disbursement of terminal benefits.

2. According to the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner, though the petitioner has retired from service on 30.09.2018, the terminal benefits were released only on 30.09.2019. Hence, the petitioner has addressed a communication to the respondents on 12.11.2024, seeking payment of interest for the belated disbursement of terminal benefits. Since there is no response, the present writ petition has been filed.
