PRAYER: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the 2nd respondent to pass orders on the petitioner's request letter, dated 11.07.2023, for accepting the voluntary retirement of the petitioner and consequently, to direct the respondents to pay the terminal benefits together with 12% interest from 11.07.2023 including eligible monthly pension from the 1st respondent.
