**PRAYER:** Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the difference amounts in the benefits in respect of Gratuity, Encashment of Earned Leave salary, Commuted value of pension and monthly pension along with Dearness Allowance and with arrears from the date of retirement i.e. 30.11.2022 as per the 14<sup>th</sup> Wage Revision Settlement dated 24.08.2022 together with interest at 6% per annum for the differential payment to be computed from the date of the petitioner's retirement till the date of payment within a time frame as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

The present Writ Petition has been filed by a retired Checking Inspector of the respondent Transport Corporation seeking benefits under the 14<sup>th</sup> wage settlement, dated 24.08.2022.

According to the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, though the settlement was reached on 24.08.2022, the wage settlement is applicable to all those employees who were in service on 01.09.2019. The petitioner has sent a representation to the respondent on 16.09.2024 seeking the said benefits. Since there is no response, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner, the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent and the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents 2 to 4.

4. Considering the above said facts, the respondents herein are directed to confer the eligible benefits upon the writ petitioner along with interest at the rate of 6% p.a., from the due date till the date of disbursement, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
