2.The General Manager of the respondent transport Corporation has filed an affidavit. The relevant portion in paragraph No.4 of the affidavit is extracted as follows:-

“However, owing to the financial constrain, this respondent could not settle the amount. As per our calculation, the writ petitioner is entitled for Rs.1,39,698/- towards gratuity, Rs.77,811/- towards difference in leave salary and I undertake to pay the same in installments. As such, a sum of Rs.34,625/- was paid on 25.06.2024 and 12.08.2024. The balance amount would be paid in 5 equal installments commencing from October 2024 to February 2025 owing to the financial constraints of the corporation.”
