ARUN, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.M.MUTHUMANICKAM, Government Advocate(Crl.side) on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P.(MD).No.4023 of 2021 in Crl.A.(MD).No.38 of 2021 on 16.06.2023.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that as per the direction of this Court, the petitioner is complying with the conditions. He further submitted that the petitioner underwent a surgery in her leg recently and is unable to perform her day-today activities and hence prayed for relaxing the condition imposed by this Court by order dated 16.06.2023.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that petitioner is not complying with the conditions imposed by this Court regularly and hence, the conditions may be modified once in three months.

4. Considering the submissions made on either side, the condition imposed as against the petitioner is modified and the petitioner is directed to report
