ORDER

The instant writ petition has been filed by the management of aided minority institution, seeking a mandamus to direct the third respondent to approve the appointment of one P.Maria Ruban as Office Assistant.

The management has forwarded the said proposals to the third respondent on 20.09.2021. So far orders have not been passed by the third respondent, the present writ petition has been filed.

Though, the proposal is pending with the fourth respondent from September 2021 onwards, the fourth respondent is directed to forward the said proposal to the third respondent within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On receipt of the same, the third respondent is directed to pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks thereafter.

5. With the above said observations, this writ petition is disposed of.
