PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.292 of 2024 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused No.3, who was arrested and remanded to judicial

custody on 25.09.2024 for the alleged offences under Sections 103(1), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS Act @ U/s. 61(2), 103(1), 296(b), 351(3) and 3(5) of BNS Act, in Crime No.292 of 2024, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that there was a previous enmity between the parties. The deceased was attacked with aruval and knife by A1 to A3 and A4 to A7 are said to have watched in a nearby place to ensure that if the deceased escaped from A1 to A3, they were prepared to attack the deceased. There are totally 7 accused persons in this case and the petitioner has been arrayed as A3. The overtact attributed against the petitioner is that he had attacked the deceased with knife.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner is a history sheet rowdy and he has 4 previous cases against him and all cases pertain to IPC offences. Considering the previous cases against the petitioner, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a false case has been foisted against the petitioner. He further submitted that the petitioner has suffered incarceration in this case from 21.09.2024 and requested this Court to enlarge the petitioner on bail by imposing any conditions.

5. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

6. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner has suffered incarceration from 21.09.2024 and this Court has already enlarged A5 and A7 on bail and also taking note of the previous cases against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Thoothukudi, and on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. and 05.30 p.m. until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
