3. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the remedies as available under law. No costs.

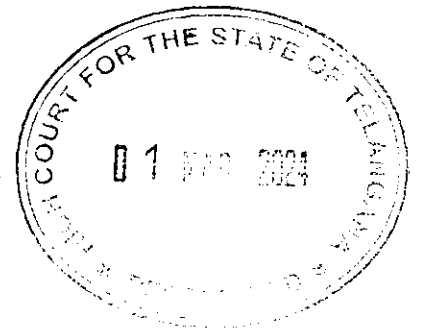
