ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by the petitioner, who is arrayed as accused to quash the proceedings against him in Case No.CC APT/0000033 of 2021 on the file of I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Khammam, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 408, 409, 420, 380 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of PDPP Act, Section 135 of Electricity Act of P.S., Bhadrachalam Town.

2. Sri S.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted that the police, after completion of investigation in the subject crime, filed charge sheet before the Court concerned and it was numbered as Calendar Case and therefore, nothing survives in this Criminal Petition for adjudication.

3. Recording the aforesaid submission, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous giving liberty to the petitioner to challenge the charge sheet if he so chooses.

4. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, in this Criminal Petition shall also stand closed.

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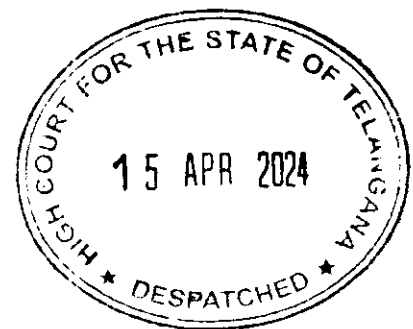
