Therefore, the learned Single Judge shall pass a separate interim order in Writ Petition No.30660 of 2023 after affording an opportunity of hearing to the parties.” It is not in dispute that in pursuance of the aforesaid order passed by the Division Bench of this Court, learned Single Judge has heard the parties on the question of interim relief in W.P.No.30660 of 2023 on 15.02.2024 and had reserved the matter for passing of the orders and the writ petition was directed to be posted for orders on 20.04.2024.
