Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action on the part of the respondents in demolishing house of petitioner No. 8-2-293/82/F/BSN/E/183, Film Nagar, Jubilee Hills is illegal and unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents reconstruct the house to put back the petitioner in that house while paying damages after setting aside the orders of the Tahsildar Shaikpet, dated 27.5.2010.

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE K.SARATH**WRIT PETITION No.19383 of 2010****ORDER:**

1. This Writ Petition is filed to questioning the action of the respondents in demolishing the house of the petitioner bearing H.No.8-2-293/82/F/BSN/E/183, Filmnagar, Bhagath Singh Colony, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad and sought a direction to the respondents to reconstruct the house and put back the petitioner in the subject house by setting aside the orders dated 27.05.2010 passed by the Respondent No.3.

2. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue and Sri Midde Arun Kumar, learned Standing Counsel for Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, appearing for the respondents.

3. Today when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that they have filed Memo in the Registry in USR

No.130921/2024 on 31.12.2024 stating that after filing the writ petition the appeal filed by the petitioner against the eviction order under Land Encroachment Act dated 27.05.2010 passed by the respondent No.3 was dismissed on 10.02.2018 vide No.B/1744/2016. Against the same, the petitioner filed Revision before the Joint Collector, Hyderabad and the same was numbered as file No.E7/31699/2018 and the same is pending.

4. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that at the time of admission this Court granted interim order on 06.08.2010 and requested to protect the interest of the petitioner till disposal of the Revision Petition filed by the petitioner.

5. In view of the submission made by the learned Counsel for the petitioner, without going into merits, this writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents not to dispossess petitioner from the subject property till disposal of the Revision Petition No.E7/31699/2018 filed by the petitioner against the order in

Proc.No.B/1744/2016 dated 10.02.2018. No order as to costs.

6. As sequel to it, Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. No order as to costs.

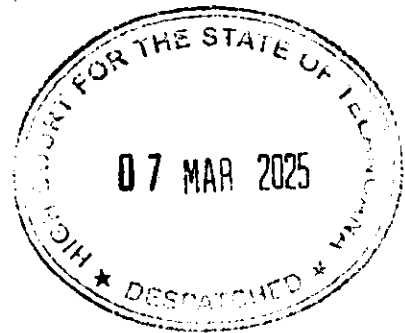
