ORDER:

The present Criminal Petition is filed seeking to quash the proceedings against the petitioner in C.C.No.9 of 2013 on the file of learned Principal Special Judge for CBI Cases at Gagan Vihar, Hyderabad.

2. No representation on behalf of the petitioner. Heard Mr. Srujan Kumar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel Special Public Prosecutor for CBI. Perused the record.
3. There is no representation for the petitioner. On the last date of hearing, when the matter was taken up for hearing, there was no representation for the petitioner, and therefore, the matter was directed to be posted today under the caption 'for dismissal'. In spite of matter being listed today under the caption 'for dismissal', there is no representation for the petitioner.
