This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri RACHAKONDA RAMAKRISHNA, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appeared for the Respondent No.2.

ORDER:

In this criminal petition, the petitioner, who is accused No.3, seek to quash the proceedings against her in C.C.No.731 of 2019 pending on the file of the First Additional Junior Civil Judge-Cum-First Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Malkajgiri.

2. After arguing for some time, when this Court has expressed its opinion stating that the said contentions are disputed questions of fact which need to be gone into by the trial Court, learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer to the extent of dispensing with the presence of the petitioner before the trial Court.

3. Hence, the appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court is dispensed with unless his presence is specifically required during the course of trial, subject to the condition of petitioner being represented by her counsel on every date of hearing.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, in this Criminal Petition shall also stand closed.

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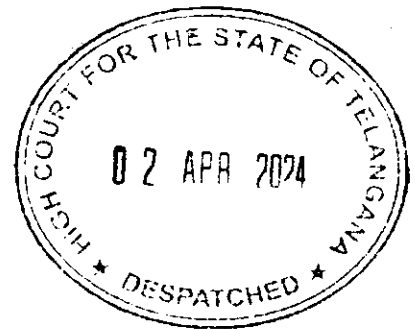
