Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ (i) to declare that the action of the Respondents in not fulfilling the conditions of Gift Deed document bearing NO.33/ 1962, dated.30/03/1962 executed by the father of the Petitioner for construction of Sri Mahaboob Reddy Basic Training School as illegal, arbitrary and liable to be set aside and (ii) to declare that the action of the Respondents in failing to adhere to the conditions precedent as specified in Gift Deed document bearing NO.33/1962, dated. 30/03/1962 executed by the father of the Petitioner, Late N.Ranga Rao and consequently declare the Gift Deed document bearing

NO.33/ 1962, dated. 30/03/1962 as void in view of the failure to perform the condition precedent as specified in the said Gift Deed, and (iii) direct the Respondents to consider the representation dated.12.10.2021, and (iv) direct the Respondents to deliver the vacant possession of the land to an extent of Ac.6.08 gts., in Sv.No.204, Narsampet (V and M), Warangal District.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2022**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.1 to consider the representation dated:12.10.2021 for resumption of land to an extent of Ac.6.08 gts., in Sy.No.204, Narsampet (V and M), Warangal District executed vide Gift Deed document bearing NO.33/1962, dated:30.03.1962.
