ORDER:

Heard Sri M.P. Chandramouli, learned Senior Designated Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Sri R. Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for TGSPDCL, appearing on behalf of respondents.

2. The petitioner approached the Court seeking prayer as under:

"to issue a writ in the nature of a Writ of *Mandamus* or any other appropriate writ direction order or orders declaring the action of the respondents in directing payment of the FSA of 2008-2009 collected in the month of July 2010 to June 2011 and adjusted by the petitioner in the C.C. bill payment of October 2012 by Letter No.SE/OP/RRC/E/SAO/JAO/HT/D No. 311, dated 21-11-2012 issued by the 2nd respondent as wholly arbitrary, illegal without jurisdiction and void and pass such other and further orders as this Honorable court deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstance of case".

3. It is represented by Sri M.P. Chandramouli, learned Senior Designated Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that the cause of action in the present writ petition does not survive for adjudication, any more.

4. **Bringing the said submission of the learned Senior Designated Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner on record, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, there shall be no order as to costs.**

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall also stand closed.

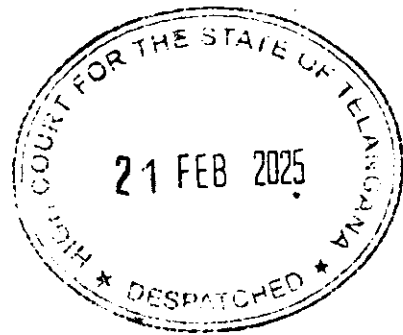
