Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records pertaining to the case CC No. 1587 of 2023 in the Court of the II Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate at Nizamabad quash the same against the petitioner/Accused No.3 by holding it to be an abuse of process of law.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri B.Balaji, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Assistant Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No. 1 and of None appeared for the Respondent No.2.

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/accused No.3 in FIR, seeking to quash the proceedings against him in C.C.No.1587 of 2023 on the file of II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, at Nizamabad, taken on file for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 326, 506 read with Section 34 of IPC.

2. Heard Sri B. Balaji, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri S. Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1 – State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that there is no role of this petitioner in the said crime as such he needs protection.

4. The petitioner is accused No.3 in C.C.No.1587 of 2023, wherein he is shown as absconding. As seen from the charge sheet averments, the police submitted that they filed separate charge sheet for accused No.3 as and when they arrested. In

view of the charge sheet, the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court and file a bail petition.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.

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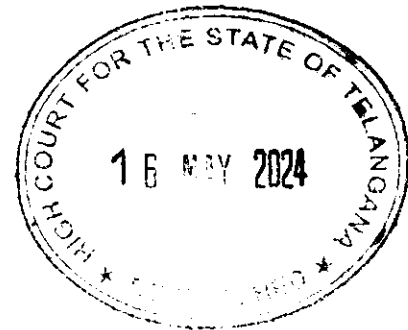
