ORDER:

Heard Sri Srinivasa Rao Madiraju, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2.

2. This Contempt Case is filed complaining violation of the order dated 07.11.2022 passed by this Court in W.P.No.15524 of 2017.

3. The relevant para No.6 of the order dated 07.11.2022 passed in W.P. No. 15524 of 2017 is extracted hereunder:

"6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition is allowed directing the respondents to pay the respective amounts recovered from the petitioners on proper acknowledgment, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Registry is directed to enclose copy of order dated 17.08.2022 passed in W.P. No.24687 of 2013 along with this writ petition. There shall be no order as to costs".

4. The learned Government Pleader for Services-I brings on record a photocopy of search status document with URN Number 2435923184 pertaining to the writ petitioner No.1 amount transaction details evidencing that an amount of Rs.3,69,948/- had been approved.

5. **Bringing the said submission of learned Government Pleader for Services-I on record, the Contempt Case is closed. However, there shall be no order as to costs.**
