The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.5806 of 2024

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/accused No.2 seeking to quash the proceedings against him in Crime No.310 of 2024 on the file of Korutla Police Station, Jagtial District, registered for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 420, 447, 427 and 506 read with 34 of IPC.

2. Heard Sri K.Venumadhav, learned counsel for the petitioners and Sri S. Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1 – State.

3. Without going into the merits of the case, since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioner is less than seven (07) years, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer on or before 14.06.2024 between 11:00 a.m. and 05:00 p.m. and in turn, the Investigating Officer is directed to follow the procedure laid down under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. and also the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme

Court of India in **Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar**¹ scrupulously. However, the petitioner shall submit his defense and co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when required by furnishing information and produce all relevant documents/material required for the purpose of the investigation and the Investigating Officer shall consider the same before filing appropriate report before the learned Magistrate concerned.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.

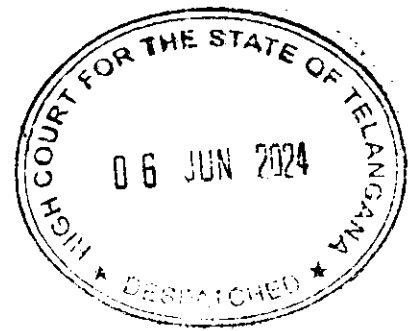
