Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ or direction preferably Writ of Mandamus declaring the

action of the respondent no. 4 in proposing to evict the petitioners from the shops leased to them situated at Thallada (VandM) of Khammam District on 1-5-2014 pursuant to the impugned notices vide Rc. No. 86/2014 dt.3- 4-2014 as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, contrary to resolution of the Gramapanchayat dt.7-3-2014 and violative of principles of natural justice and consequently direct the respondent no 4 to renew the leases of the petitioners for further period in respect of their shops.
