Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to Issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus to declaring the to issue a writ order or direction more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declare that the petitioner is entitled to continue in VIth class as per her admission No.635 in 1st respondent school and to continue her in higher classes as per the scheme with all consequential benefits as she is only single girl child to her parents by holding the action of the respondents in canceling the admission of the petitioner in VI th class by issuing impugned Transfer Certificate dt.30.10.2012 in the middle of the academic year straight away without giving any opportunity or notice, which is clearly illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of principles of natural justice

**The petitioner approached the Court seeking
prayer as under:**

"....to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of *Mandamus* to declare that the petitioner is entitled to continue in VIth class as per her admission No.635 in 1st respondent school and to continue her in higher classes as per the scheme with all consequential benefits as she is only single girl child to her parents by holding the action of the respondents in cancelling the admission of the petitioner in VIth class by issuing impugned Transfer Certificate dated 30.10.2012 in the middle of the academic year straight away without giving any opportunity or notice, which is clearly illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of principles of natural justice and to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit just and proper in the circumstances of the case".

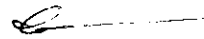

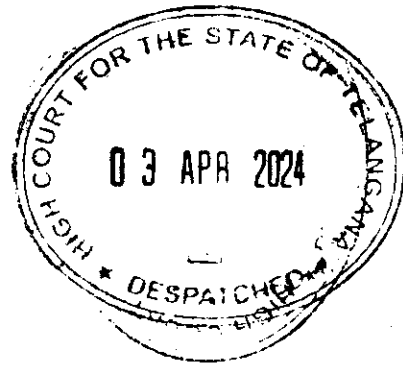
