JUDGMENT:

This appeal is filed against the judgment and decree dated 26.03.2008 passed in O.S.No.582 of 2006 on the file of the III Senior Civil Judge, City Civil Court at Secunderabad.

2. A suit vide O.S.No.582 of 2006 was filed in the year 2006 for recovery of amount was decreed with interest on 26.03.2008 and aggrieved by the said order; defendant in the suit preferred this appeal.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel for the respondent present.

4. It is stated that during the pendency of the appeal, an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- was paid towards full and final settlement and receipt was also passed to that effect on 09.02.2012 and the copy of the same is filed before the Court and stated that the said amount is treated towards full and final settlement and thus appellant intended to withdraw the appeal.

5. As it is a suit for recovery of amount and Rs.4,00,000/- was treated towards full and final settlement and also on considering the receipt this Court finds that it is just and reasonable to close the appeal.

6. Accordingly C.C.C.A is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions, pending if any, shall stand closed.

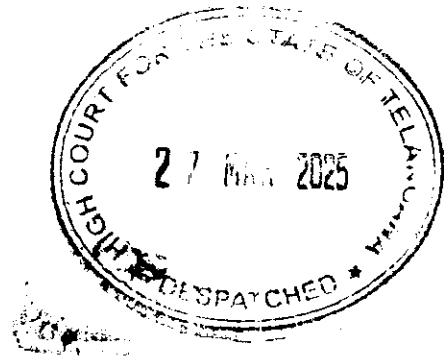
