

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE N. TUKARAMJI

CRIMINAL PETITION No.7085 OF 2024

ORDER:

1. This Criminal Petition is filed under Sections 437 and 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short "Cr.P.C") seeking regular bail.
2. The petitioners are accused Nos.1 and 2 in Crime No.470 of 2024 on the file of the Patancheru Police Station, Sangareddy District, within the territorial jurisdiction of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, (Excise & Prohibitions) at Sangareddy.
3. I have heard Sri Muzafferullah Khan, learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State.
4. The prosecution case in brief is that in regard to purchase of land, on 25.05.2024, the accused waylaid with an intention to do away with the life but apprehending danger the de facto complainant could

manage to escape, by leaving his four wheeler and the petitioners had attacked and badly damaged his car. Thus, committed offences under Sections 341, 427, 506 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the case. Even, as per the prosecution the de facto complainant suffered no harm but vehicle was damaged. The petitioners are in judicial remand since 28.05.2024 and the entire investigation is completed. The petitioners are ready to assist the judicial process and abide by any condition that may be imposed. Hence, prayed for grant of bail.

6. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed bail application and would submit that investigation is completed except for filing of charge sheet.

7. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel and perused the materials placed on record.

8. Having regard to the stage of investigation reported by the prosecution and in absence of any other imperative ground for continuance of the petitioners in remand, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner's prayer for grant of bail can be accepted.

9. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed on the following conditions:

- i) The petitioners/accused Nos.1 and 2 shall be released on bail, on each of them executing a self bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, (Excise & Prohibitions) at Sangareddy.
- ii) Further, the petitioners are directed to make themselves available for the judicial process on every adjournment, except for the leave of the Court.
- iii) The petitioners shall not interfere or intimidate the prosecution witnesses nor shall attempt to tamper with the evidence.

- iv) The petitioners shall inform their residence and contact particulars to the investigating officer in an affidavit and update the same from time to time till conclusion of the criminal case.
- v) The petitioners shall not indulge in any illegal activity. If the petitioners commit any breach of the above conditions, the investigating agency/prosecution shall be at liberty to initiate proceedings for cancellation of bail.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
