ORDER:

Heard Mr. Koushik Kanduri, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Energy appearing on behalf of respondent No.1, Mr. R. Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for TSSPDCL appearing for respondent Nos.2 to 5 and Mr. M.A.K. Muheed, learned Standing Counsel for Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation appearing for respondent No.6.

2. The petitioner approached the Court seeking prayer as under:

"...to issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT of MANDAMUS directing the respondent No.2 to 5 to act in accordance with law and to release service connections along with electrical meters to the petitioner herein for Plot No.62, admeasuring 300 Sq.Yards, in Sy.Nos.11/19, 11/20, 11/21 situated at Khanamet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, under

GHMC Serilingampally Circle, Ranga Reddy District without being influenced by the instructions of the 6th respondent and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstance of the case".

3. It is represented by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel for TSSPDCL appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.2 to 5 that the subject issue in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the order of this Court dated 21.06.2024 passed in W.P.No.15603 of 2024, hence, the writ petition could be disposed of in terms of the aforesaid order.

4. Bringing the said submission of both the learned counsel on record, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent Nos.2 to 5 to release electricity service connection and meter to the petitioner's Plot No.62, admeasuring 300 Sq.Yards, in Sy.Nos.11/19, 11/20, 11/21 situated at Khanamet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, under GHMC Serilingampally Circle, Ranga Reddy District

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within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order, and the same shall be subject to further direction that may be issued by the State of Telangana or the Apex Court in the litigation pending before it arising out of the order dated 12.09.2012 in writ petition No.20407 of 2008 and batch. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.

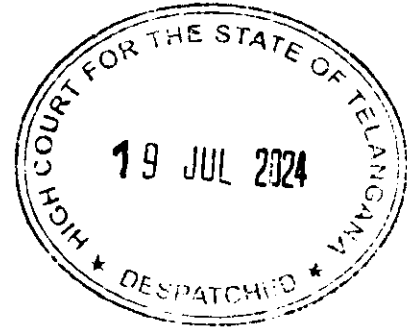
