Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the impugned action of respondents in not appointing the petitioner in the post of Trainee Sub Engineer(Mechanical) meant for SC(General) notified in Notification No. 4/CGM(ADM)/2010, dt.3-1-2011 and further action of respondents in keeping several notified post vacant inspite of availability of candidates on merit like the petitioner as highly illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 14 and 16 of Constitution of India.

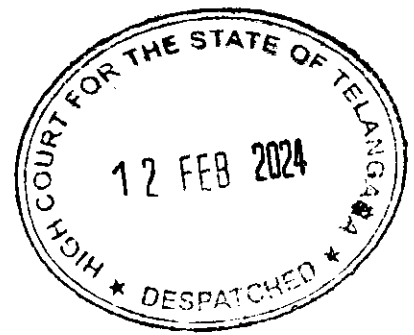
